



Update: Sheboygan City Hall Construction



Quasius Construction recently began this \$10.5 million restoration of the Sheboygan City Hall.

After years of debate and planning, the City of Sheboygan City Hall renovation is now underway. Little remains except for subtle reminders of where fixtures, walls, and windows once were inside the fully-gutted Sheboygan City Hall. The \$10.5 million renovation and atrium addition of the century old building is on schedule to be completed in Spring 2019.


Throughout the demolition, Quasius has worked meticulously to preserve the integrity of iconic elements including the marble staircase and third floor council chambers, which will be fully restored. Additionally, to enhance labor production, safety and efficiency on the project, robots were used to demolish the interior walls on each of the floors.

Terracotta structural clay tile and clay load-bearing wall tile—commonly used in the 1900s and found throughout the building—will be reinforced with resistance piers. Upon completion,

construction will begin on the north three-story glass curtain and atrium encasing the historic staircase and allowing natural light to flood the center of the building. Masons continue to work to restore and in-fill masonry on the north and west sides of the building that has aged over the lifespan of the building. This will ensure its existence and original beauty for future generations.

Work will continue through the Fall of 2018 and Winter of 2019 on each of the three floors and basement, replacing the existing windows with new. During that time, work will also begin on the layout of the new office floors. As part of the renovation, HVAC, electrical, plumbing, fire protection and technology, will be also be updated. The new City Hall facility will feature a modern office and customer-centric atmosphere.



Quasius Construction broke ground on the 25,158 square foot Hiawatha National Bank and Headquarters in Plymouth Wisconsin. Designed to accommodate the needs and abilities of all guests, the multi-level, structure utilizes a mix of natural textures, lighting, and ADA design components.

The financial institution will feature an impressive glass window façade providing guests a 180-degree view of the exquisite landscape and living roof. Inside, exposed glue-lam post and beams frame the ceiling, accentuated with vertical tongue and groove cladding, and stone veneer to create an organic inspired environment. In addition, the project includes a paver driveway, rain garden, and large outdoor green space, with night lighting, for community and bank events throughout the year.
